Chef David Bouley's newest restaurant Brushstroke opened in Tribeca this week. The Japanese a la carte menu offers a full selection of sushi, sashimi and seasonal plates such as Chawan-mushi egg custard with Dungeness crab and black truffle sauce or green tea smoked duck with matcha salt. But you'll want to go for the hyper-seasonal prix fixe. Six-, eight- or 10-course meals are offered (\$85–\$135), all of which are designed to blow your mind.
