Brushstroke Adds Sushi Bar and Recruits Ichimura



Eiji Ichimura will man Brushstroke's new sushi bar, according to *The New York Times*.

The year-old restaurant's eight-seat bar had formerly been used for liquor, but David Bouley said the change was part of his plan all along.

"We had always planned to do sushi. It was just a matter of figuring it out. Now we have brought in a master and he needed his own venue," Bouley told the *Times*.

The sushi bar will offer two seatings per night for omakese sushi menus starting at \$150. Reservations are required.
