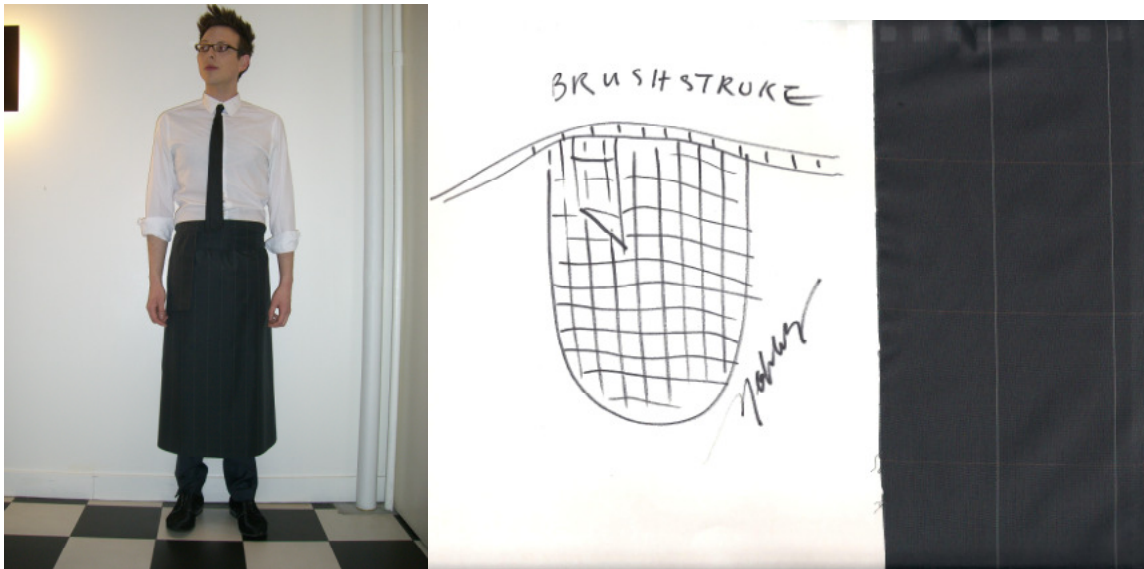
YEOHLEE COLLABORATES ON UNIFORMS FOR NEW DAVID BOULEY RESTAURANT BRUSHSTROKE
